Quality teaching for all






- CPD programme focussed on PP strategies to improve achievement and engagement
- Quality Assurance Cycle to have a strong PP focus – launch of Class Performance Reviews (CPRs), DTT model
- Smaller class sizes in English and Maths
- Use of Common Individual Education Plans (CIEPs) to support learning
- Year Leaders to focus on celebrating achievement, attitude to learning and attendance
- PP students a focus in all faculty meetings
- Use of Lexia and Accelerated Reader in English lessons
- Data Manager employed September 2018 to support the use of Class Charts and SISRA to track behaviour, attendance and progress
- NECOP programme to support teaching of PSHE
- Blue pathway staffing and curriculum delivery






Targeted intervention

- Intervention staff in Core and Ebacc, PP students a focus for literacy catch up sessions
- Tracking PP student progress regularly at fortnightly RA meetings at KS3 (English, Maths, Science) and KS4 Bucket 1 and 2
- Achievement Leaders/Year managers to interview and support students, special focus on PP students, especially High on Entry
- Extra sessions for students during holidays and after school (I6 and R6)
- English, Maths and Science revision days at KS4
- Behaviour and attendance team – PT EWO employed September 2018
- Homework and Breakfast clubs
- Counsellor time increased x2 to support vulnerable students
