Dear Parents/Carers,

Re: Year 10 Parents Evening

I would like to invite you to our Year 10 Parents' Evening, which will take place on Thursday 3rd May, from 4.00pm until 6.45pm. **Please note that parents cannot be admitted into the school building before 4pm for health and safety reasons.**

During the evening teachers will discuss your child's progress and effort. Staff can offer guidance on how you can support your child in their new KS4 courses from home. You will also have the opportunity to discuss deadlines for non-exam assessments and teachers can give details of the exams that your son/daughter will sit and when these will take place. Representation from local colleges and further educational establishments will also be present to answer any questions you may have about post 16 education provision.

Seaham High School is currently trialing a **no-appointment system** for parents' evening. This system will be new for parents who do not have children in lower school. It will simply mean that you can visit staff in any order without the requirement of a specific timed appointment. Appointments will still be limited to approximately five minutes in order to ensure that all parents/carers have the opportunity to see all teachers. If you find that five minutes has not been sufficient time to discuss your child's progress then you can arrange to visit school at a later date and meet with myself.

Due to the significant changes made to Key Stage Four qualifications in recent years, attendance is of vital importance. Further to this, we urge you to inform us if you are unable to attend so that we can make alternative arrangements to meet with you.

Finally, on arrival we ask that you sign in and take the opportunity to complete a change of details form if any of your personal information has changed. Over the course of the academic year and into year 11, details of intervention and support will be disseminated via email and text message. We will also communicate any closures or urgent information via text message so it is important that we hold accurate details. You will also receive details of your son/daughters mock examination timetable on arrival.

Thank you for your continued support and I look forward to meeting as many parents on 3rd May as possible.
