**Re: Year 11 Parents Evening**

I would like to invite you to our Year 11 Parents' Evening, which will take place on Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> November 2018, from 4.00pm until 6.45pm. **Please note that parents cannot be admitted into the school building before 4pm for health and safety reasons.**

During the evening teachers will discuss your child's progress and attitude to learning. Staff can offer guidance on how you can support your child in their KS4 courses from home as well as talking through the homework requirements for year 11. You will also have the opportunity to discuss deadlines for non-exam assessments and teachers can give details of the exams that your son/daughter will sit and when these will take place. Representation from local colleges and further educational establishments will also be present to answer any questions you may have about post-16 education provision.

Following the success of the **no-appointment system** for parents' evenings in the 2017-18 academic year, the system will operate for both parents' evenings this year. It will simply mean that you can visit staff in any order without the requirement of a specific timed appointment. Appointments will still be limited to approximately five minutes in order to ensure that all parents/carers have the opportunity to see all teachers. If you find that five minutes has not been sufficient time to discuss your child's progress then you can arrange to visit school at a later date where I will be happy to meet you.

As I am sure you appreciate, year 11 is a critical time for students as we approach final exams. Attendance at the Parents' Evening is therefore essential in order to support your son/daughter in their preparation for the challenges ahead in year 11. Further to this, we urge you to inform us if you are unable to attend so that we can make alternative arrangements to meet with you.

Thank you for your continued support and I look forward to seeing as many parents again on 22<sup>nd</sup> November.
